- 7. The equipment/software/technology will not be used for foreign production or technical assistance purposes; and,
- 8. I will take the appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to the equipment/software/technology which include:
  - a. The technology/software/equipment will be in my possession at all times or in a secure location (i.e., hotel room safe);
