

Equipment Certification for Travel to Cuba

(Per EAR 746.2 (a) (1) License Exceptions, EAR 740.14 Baggage (BAG) and OFACs Cuban Asset Regulations 31 CFR Part 515)

I will be traveling to Cuba as part of my studies, research or other official duties here at the University of Florida. While on travel to Cuba I plan to take certain equipment/software/technology with me (see attached list for details) and certify that the following is true and correct:

1. I am a US person – defined as a US citizen, permanent resident or protected individual.
2. The equipment/software/technology that I will be taking with me to Cuba is my own personal property.
3. I will neither sale nor dispose of the equipment/software/technology while in Cuba.
4. I will take the equipment/software/technology with me when I leave Cuba.
5. I will not take with me any encryption commodities or software categorized as E1 on the controlled commodities list.
6. The equipment/software/technology will be accessed and used solely by me during my travels to and within Cuba.
7. The equipment/software/technology will not be used for foreign production or technical assistance purposes; and,
8. I will take the appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to the equipment/software/technology which include:
 - a. The technology/software/equipment will be in my possession at all times or in a secure location (i.e., hotel room safe);
 - b. I will ensure that I use secure connections;
 - c. I will ensure that I use password systems; and,
 - d. I will ensure that I use personal firewalls.
