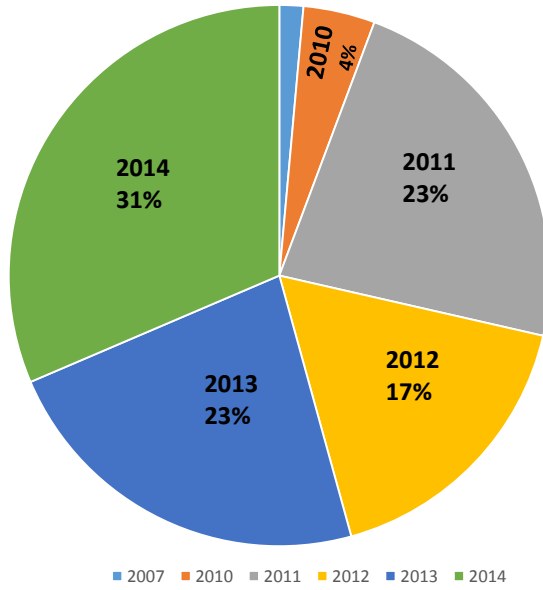


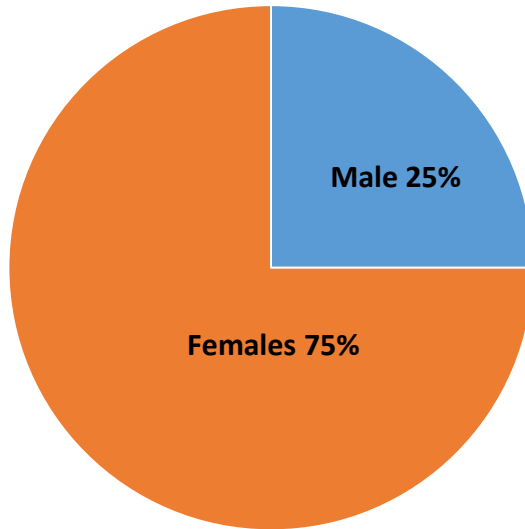

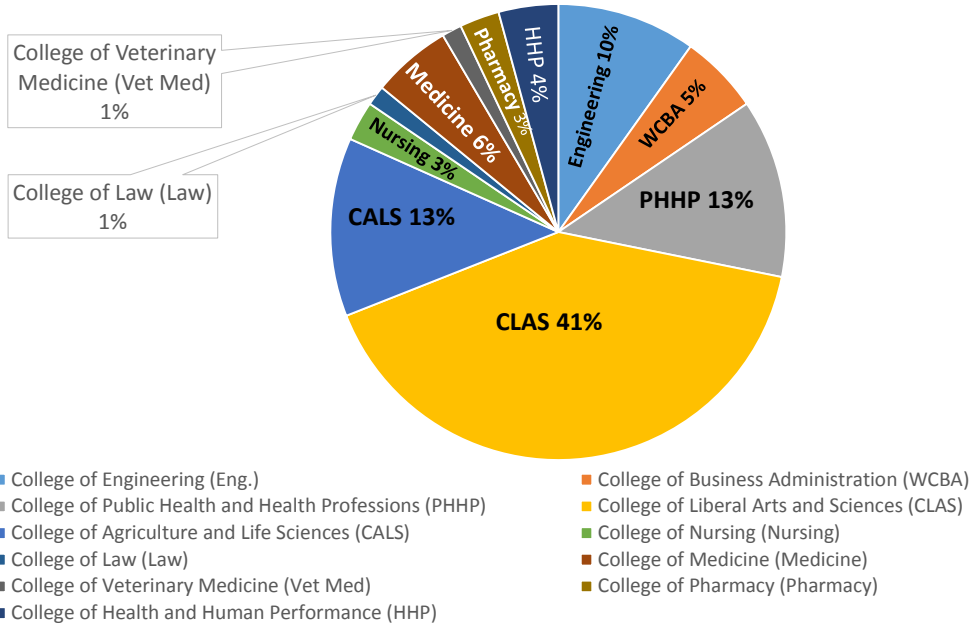
When did you first matriculate into the University of Florida?



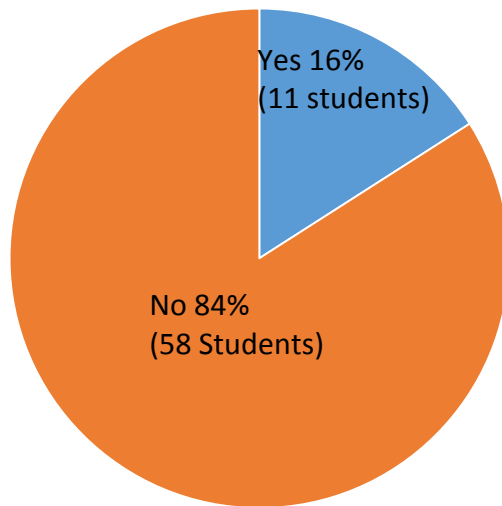
Gender Breakdown



What department affiliation(s) do you have?

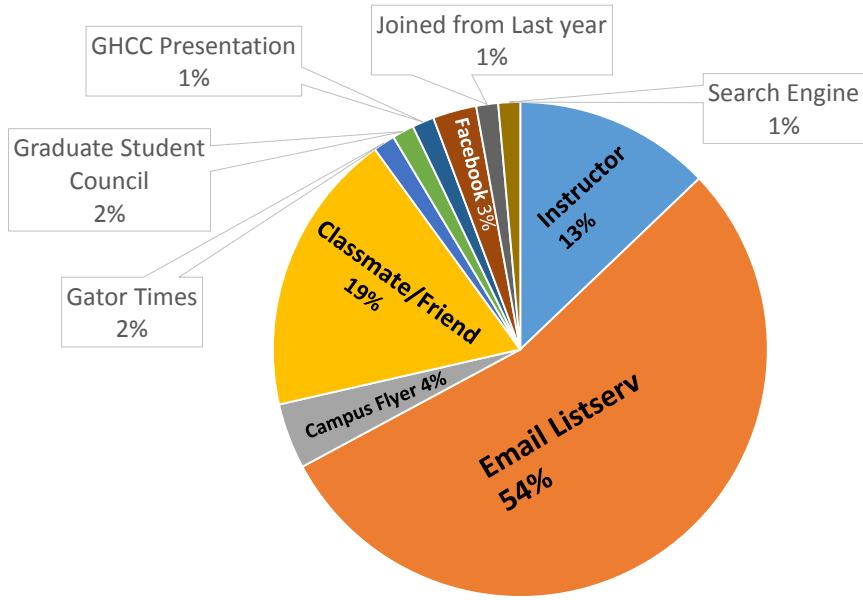


Did you participate in the 2014 Global Health Case Competition?

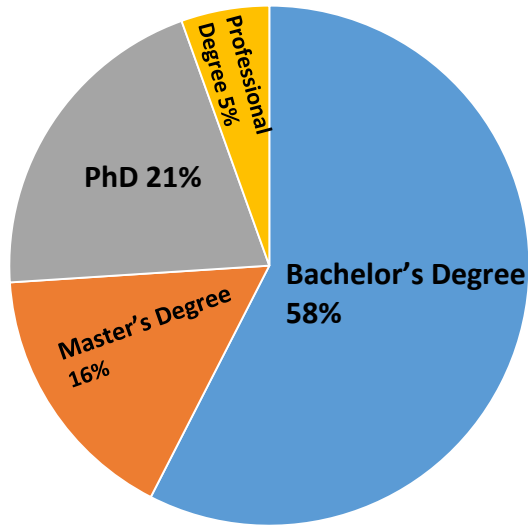

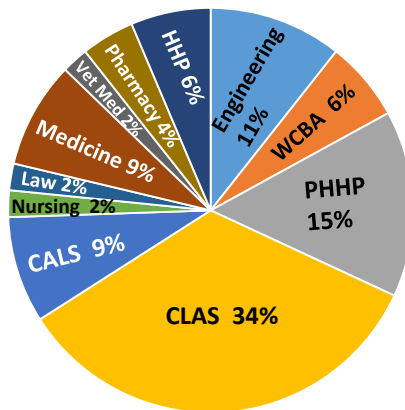
What type of degree program are you in?

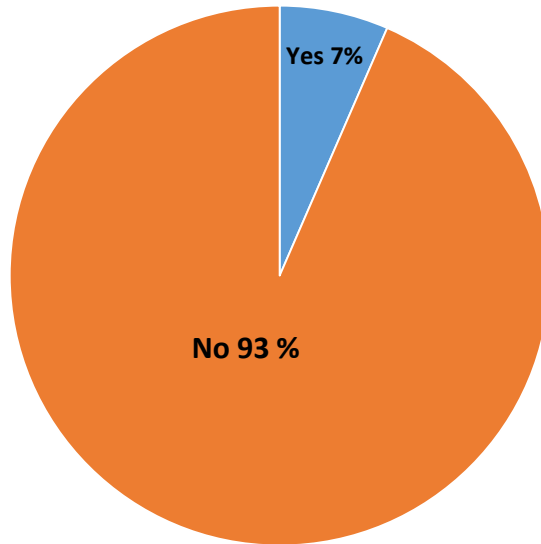

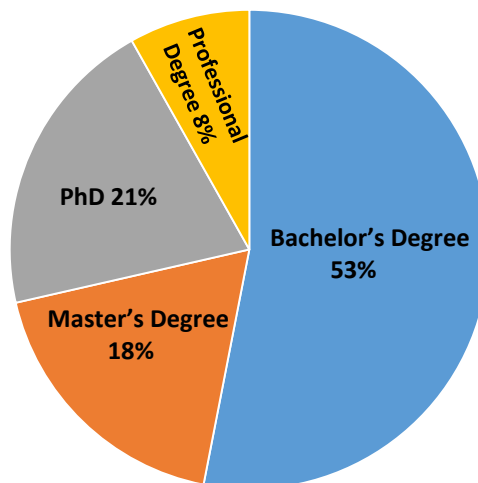

What type of degree program are you in?



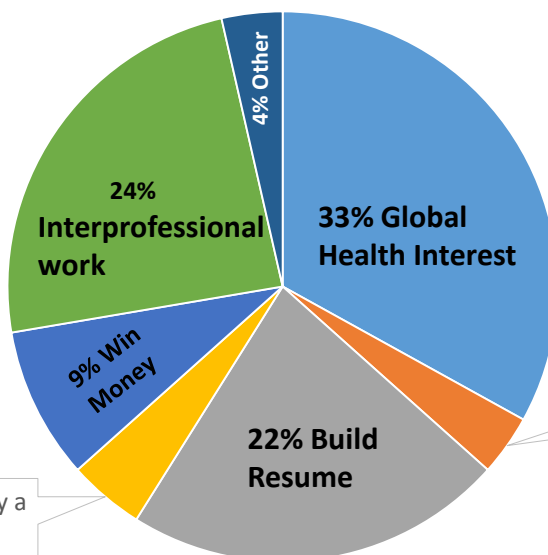
