Dr. Reichow's current research interests include the translation of clinical research into everyday practices in real-life settings. Dr. Reichow is an ongoing technical advisor for the World Health Organization is currently working with colleagues at the WHO to develop practice guidelines and training materials to increase the identification, management, and treatment of children with developmental disabilities in lower- and middle-income countries.

Global Research Interests

- Capacity building of community health workers and other non-specialist providers through task-shifting activities.
- Increase the identification of children with developmental disabilities in lower- and middle-income countries.
- Increase local capacity in lower- and middle-income countries to provide treatments and services for children with developmental disabilities and their families.
- Collaboration with World Health Organization on the development of an open-source parent skills training program for caregivers who have a child with a developmental disability.
