Materials Needed:

1. Notes on countries of Western Europe

- 2. Map of Western Europe
- 3. Compare and Contrast Diagram
- 4. Venn Diagram
- 5. Venn Diagram with Summary paragraph
- 6. Pens, pencils, and highlighters

Procedures:

- 1. Discuss the notes on each country of Western Europe with students using maps.
- 2. Students will highlight important information on physical geography, human geography, and economics. Examples of the notes can be found here (LINK).
- 3. Using two of the seven countries of Western Europe, students will compare and contrast countries that are adjacent to another. They will do this in one of three ways
 - Use the compare and contrast diagram
 - Use the Venn Diagram
 - Use the Venn Diagram with summary paragraph, stating what is unique about the two countries you have compared
- 4. Remind the students that the highlighted information will be used for study and for questions on future exams.
