Exchange partners will need to verify English language proficiency for prospective exchange students during the online nomination process through the ISSS portal.

Exchange students can meet English proficiency if:

- 1. The student is a citizen of a country where English is an official language. Please see <a href="here">here</a> for a list of English exemption countries.
- 2. The student is attending university in a country where English is an official language OR at a university where English is the language of instruction. Please see <a href="here">here</a> for a list of English exemption countries.
- 3. The student has taken any of the following official tests of English language competence and received a sufficient score:

TOEFL iBT: 80
TOEFL PBT: 550
Verbal GRE: 140

GATEWAY English Test: 425

• CEFR: B2

4. The student has a letter of English verification from their home institution, confirming that they have a sufficient language proficiency to successfully navigate day-to-day life in the United States, read and comprehend program materials, and know how to obtain assistance, if necessary.
