- Define the goals and objectives of the proposed research project;
- Provide information about the relevance of the host institution to the proposed research, with details about the collaboration with UF;
- A work plan that shall include:
 - Description of the work to be accomplished by the graduate student during the period abroad;
- How RAD will prepare you for the world of global research engagement.

6. LETTERS OF SUPPORT FROM YOUR GRADUATE ADVISOR

The letter should affirm:

- The candidate's strengths as a graduate student and relevance of the proposed activity to their research project
- Support for the candidate to engage fully in the program and fulfil the required program responsibilities, including any financial support
- Contribution of the proposed international research activity to the development of an institutional relationship between UF and the foreign institution

7. LETTER FROM THE FOREIGN RESEARCH INSTITUTION

The letter should confirm that the institution agrees to host the UF student and support routine expenses associated with their research (they are not required to cover living expenses). The letters can be addressed to RAD Review Committee and should be included in your PDF application package.
