### Frequently Asked Questions

#### Questions #1 and #4

- All J-1 visa holders will answer Yes to questions #1 and #4. In the "Please explain any "yes" answers" section, enter:
  - **#1: Yes; I entered the U.S. on** *(the date you arrived in the U.S. based on your [Get Most Recent I-94](#) Arrival information)*
  - **#4: Yes; I am eligible to work as an J-1 visa holder.**

- The answers to questions # 2 and #3 will depend on each J-1 visa holder's individual experience and should only be answered Yes if it pertains to your specific situation. Otherwise, answer No.
